





A Year of Milestones for IAOMS

While the IAOMS Foundation advanced its mission through fellowships, scholarships, and global education programs, IAOMS itself also marked important milestones in 2024–2025. 
Leadership Transition

In early 2025, IAOMS welcomed **Dr. Larry Nissen** as Executive Director. This transition marked a new chapter in the Association’s leadership, bringing renewed focus on member value, organizational growth, and expanded global engagement.

OMS Included In WHO Standards

In 2025, Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery achieved landmark recognition at the global level. The World Health Organization (WHO) officially included OMS within its revised **Standards and Recommendations for Surgical Care in Emergencies**, expanding upon the foundational Emergency Medical Teams “Blue Book.”

Through the leadership of IAOMS representatives working closely with WHO technical groups, our specialty now has a defined role in the international emergency response framework — a milestone that underscores the critical expertise OMS brings to global health crises.





Revitalization of IAOMS Scientific Webinars

IAOMS reimagined its Scientific Webinar Series, introducing new, on-demand content and expanding access to non-members. These changes increase flexibility for members navigating busy schedules while also expanding the reach of IAOMS education.



IAOMS also created a new, public-access webinar library allowing visitors to browse webinars under their topic of choice.

IAOMS Virtual Conference In Partnership with Osteo Science Foundation



In December 2024, IAOMS partnered with the Osteo Science Foundation to host a global Virtual Conference on advanced oral and maxillofacial techniques. The program featured **Tara Aghaloo, DDS, MD, PhD** on the use of blood products in regeneration and **Jorge Caubet Biayna GJJ, MD, PhD, FEBOMS** on managing complex cases in the aesthetic region.



Surgeons from around the world gained practical strategies, CE credits, and direct engagement with international experts, reinforcing IAOMS' commitment to accessible, high-impact education. By joining forces, IAOMS and the Osteo Science Foundation expanded global access to expert-driven, high-impact education, equipping surgeons with knowledge to advance practice and improve patient outcomes.




ICOMS 2025: Building Community, Advancing the Specialty, & Breaking Records



Fellowship Program: Building Global Expertise

The IAOMS Foundation Fellowship Program is one of the most transformative opportunities available to young oral and maxillofacial surgeons. Fellows receive a \$25,000 stipend to support housing, travel, and educational expenses, ensuring they can train internationally without financial burden.

Placed in highly respected global institutions under the mentorship of world-renowned surgeons, IAOMS Foundation Fellows gain intensive, hands-on training in areas such as cleft and craniofacial surgery, oncologic and microvascular reconstruction, and temporomandibular joint and orthognathic surgery. They work side by side with multidisciplinary teams, gaining exposure to cutting-edge procedures, treatment planning, and patient care in diverse settings.

This year-long immersion is designed to expand clinical skills, deepen cultural and professional perspectives, and foster lifelong global networks. When Fellows return home, they bring new surgical expertise and also the ability to elevate patient care and mentor the next generation of surgeons in their communities.

Visiting Scholars Program: Short-Term Training, Long-Term Impact

The IAOMS Foundation's Visiting Scholars Program provides early-career surgeons with the chance to undertake **focused, short-term, observational training** experiences at leading institutions around the world. Unlike the one-year Fellowship, these immersive programs last two to four weeks and are designed to give Scholars direct exposure to specialized surgical techniques, research collaborations, and international best practices.

Visiting Scholars are fully embedded in their host institution — observing surgeries, gaining knowledge of clinical care decisions, and learning from some of the specialty's top surgeons. This exposure **strengthens their technical skills** and also **builds global perspectives** that enrich their careers long after the program ends.

For many, the Visiting Scholars Program serves as a catalyst for professional growth, providing mentorship, fostering international collaborations, and shaping future leaders in OMFS.






Expanding Scholarships and Global Reach: Broadening access across fellowships, visiting scholar programs, and ICOMS travel experiences.


