IAOMS FOUNDATION FELLOWSHIP

Now in its ninth year, the IAOMS Foundation Fellowship Program offers three trainee surgeons a one-year immersion in one of two specialty areas: Oncology and Microvascular Reconstructive Surgery (offered in Beijing, China and Shanghai, China) or Cleft Lip and Palate and Craniofacial Surgery (six months in Bangalore, India and six months in Hyderabad, India). Since its inception, 24 surgeons have received Fellowships. Each year, one of these fellowships is sponsored through the ongoing support of the KLS Martin Group.

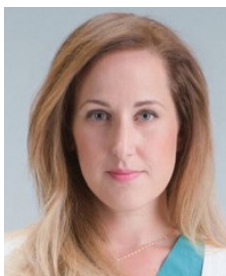

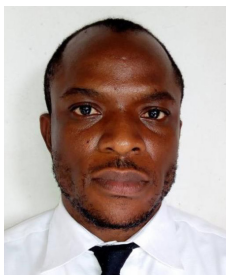
VISITING SCHOLARS PROGRAM

GIFT OF KNOWLEDGE PROGRAM

The Gift of Knowledge Program offers customized training throughout the world. IAOMS leaders volunteer their time to design, promote and implement comprehensive educational sessions, particularly in high need areas. Thus far, we have participated in the following:

The Mexican Microvascular Training Program

On October 25, 2018, the first module for the IAOMS - AMCBMC (La Asociación Mexicana de Cirugía Bucal y Maxilofacial, Colegio) took place at the Autonomous National University of México (UNAM), in conjunction with the National Government Health Care System for Federal workers (ISSSTE) with representation of all of these institutions.



Dominican Republic Program

In conjunction with Sociedad Dominicana de Cirugía Bucal y Maxilofacial (SODOCIBUMAX) leaders from the IAOMS and Asociación Latinoamericana de Cirugía y Traumatología (ALACIBU) conducted the first of a two-part course on Reconstructive Surgery. The course took place on March 16 –17 in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic. The second part of the course focusing on Current Concepts in Orthognathic & Aesthetic Facial Surgery, is slated to take place in April 2019.

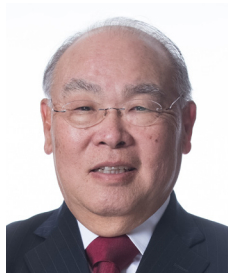
